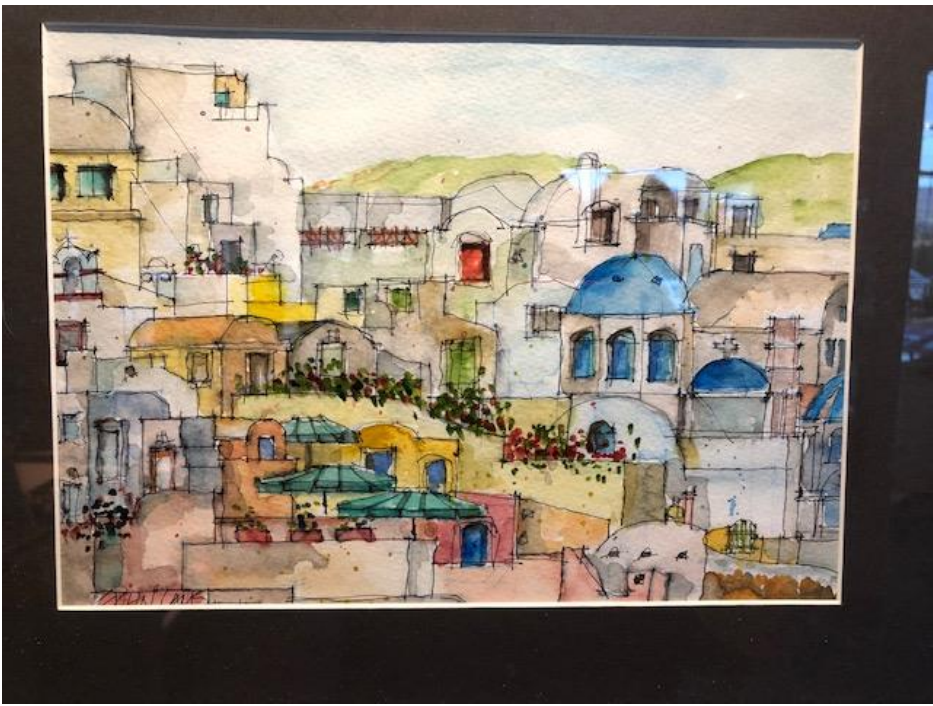

Our refreshment table was impressive. Many thanks to our generous members.



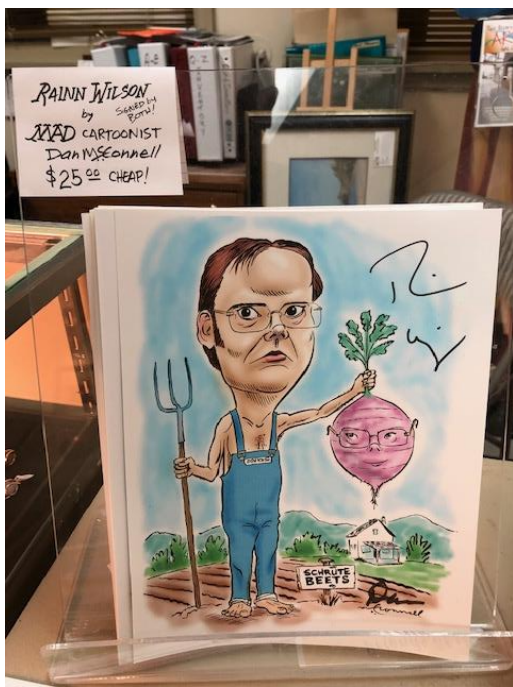

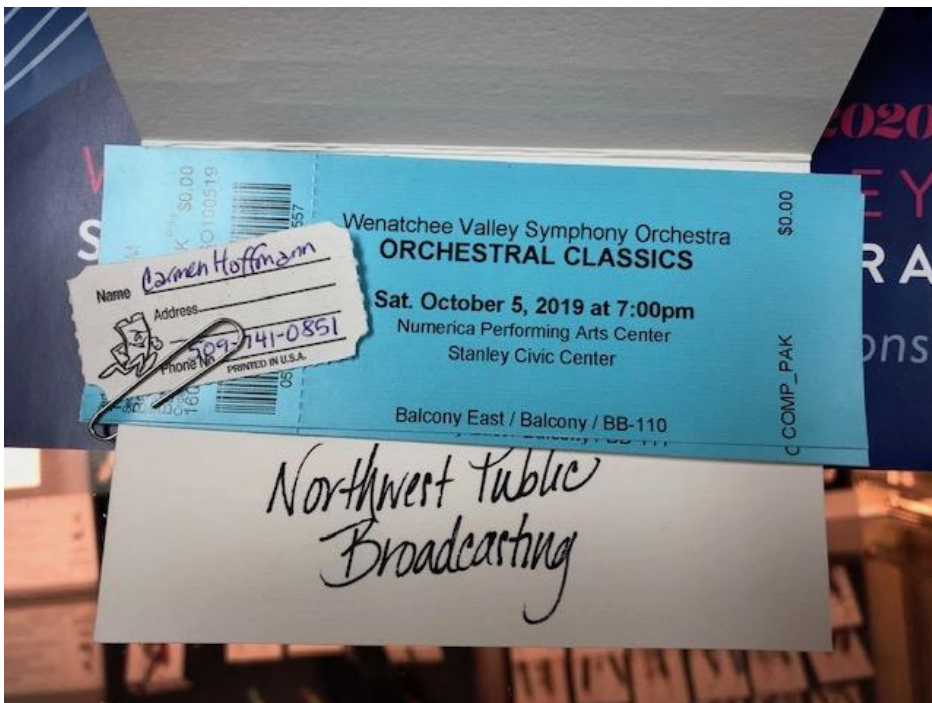

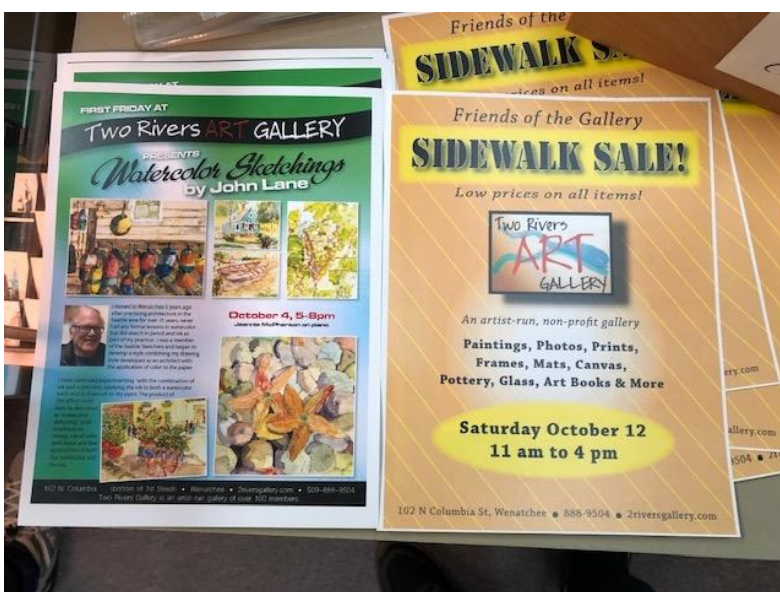
Sold! A signed print of Rainn Wilson who acted the part of Dwight Schrute in "The Office" a series on NBC TV.
