

This is Rod's first showing at Two Rivers.

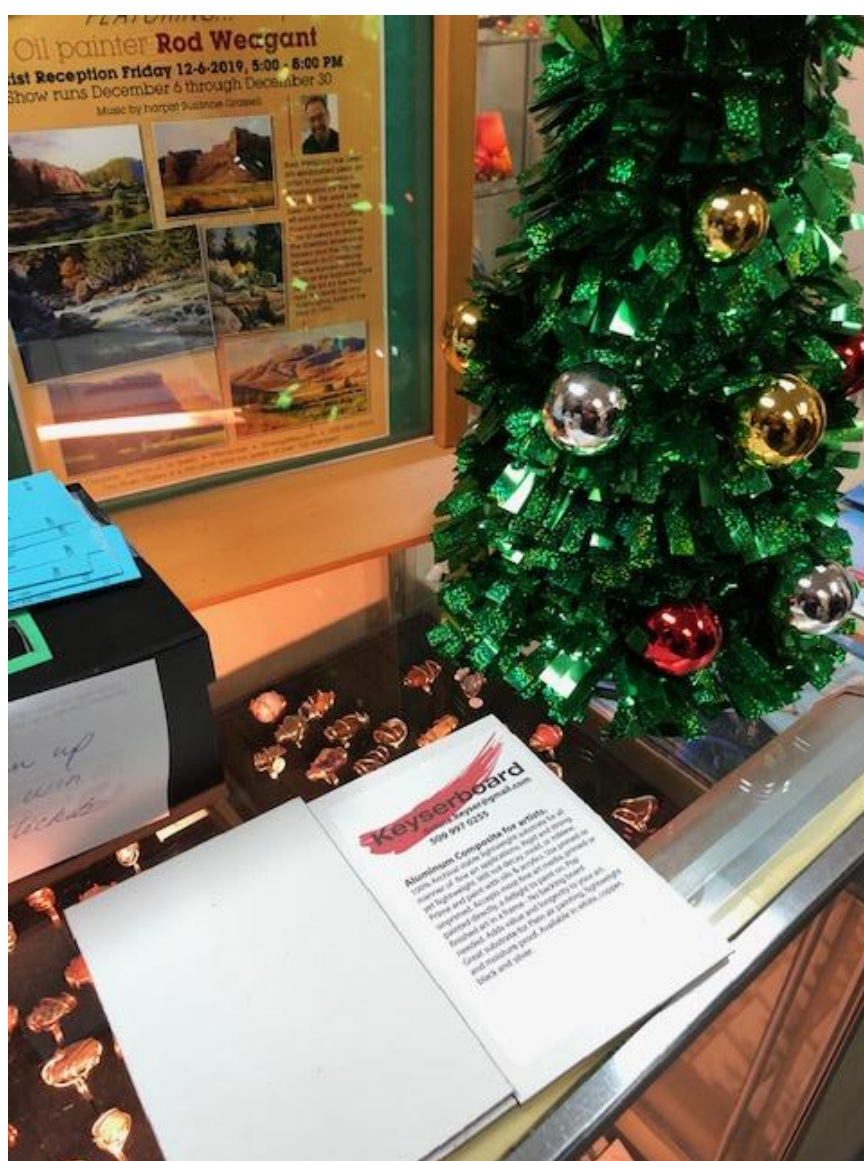




Rod spoke of his first sale to Jen Evenhus and Dan McConnell describing how he applied the paint onto a copper panel.



Sold! 'Rainbow Falls' was his first sale of the show.

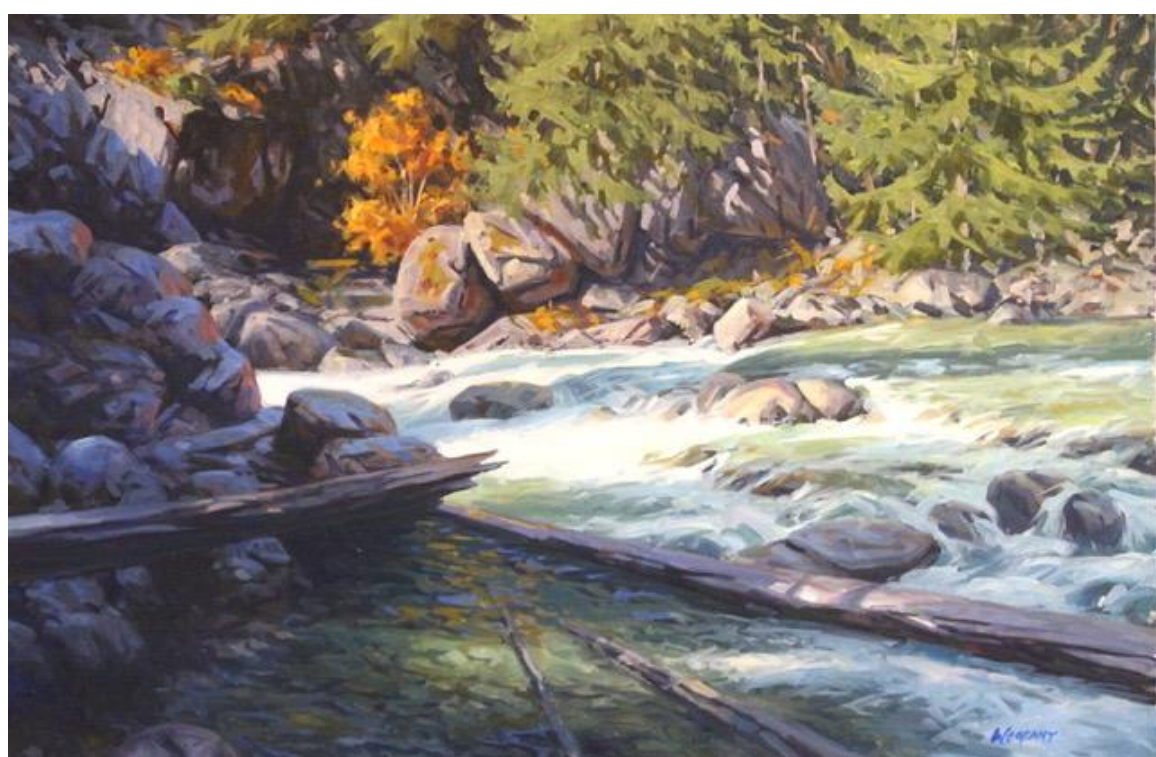


Weagant brought samples of a sign product that he shared with other artists. This product is used by Terry Johnson for his commercial signs and is something for oil/acrylic artists to consider.

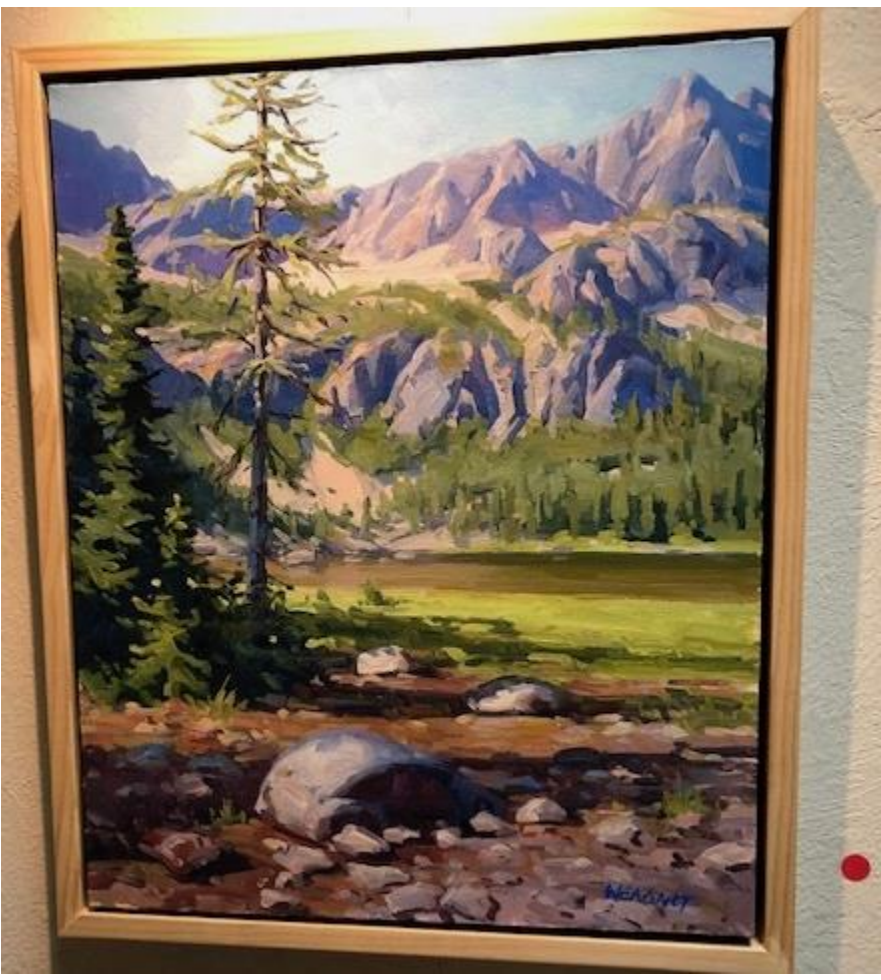


SOLD! This painting was on the poster and was second to sell.
