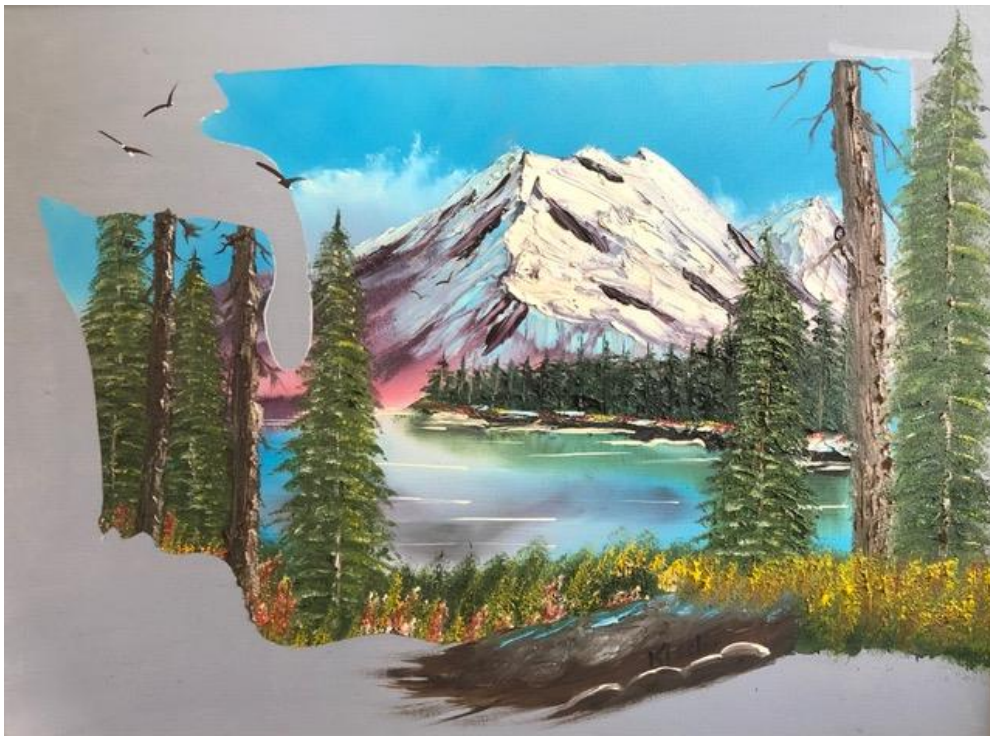
Albert Kissler was the host for the evening.

He also paints buildings like this ski hut.



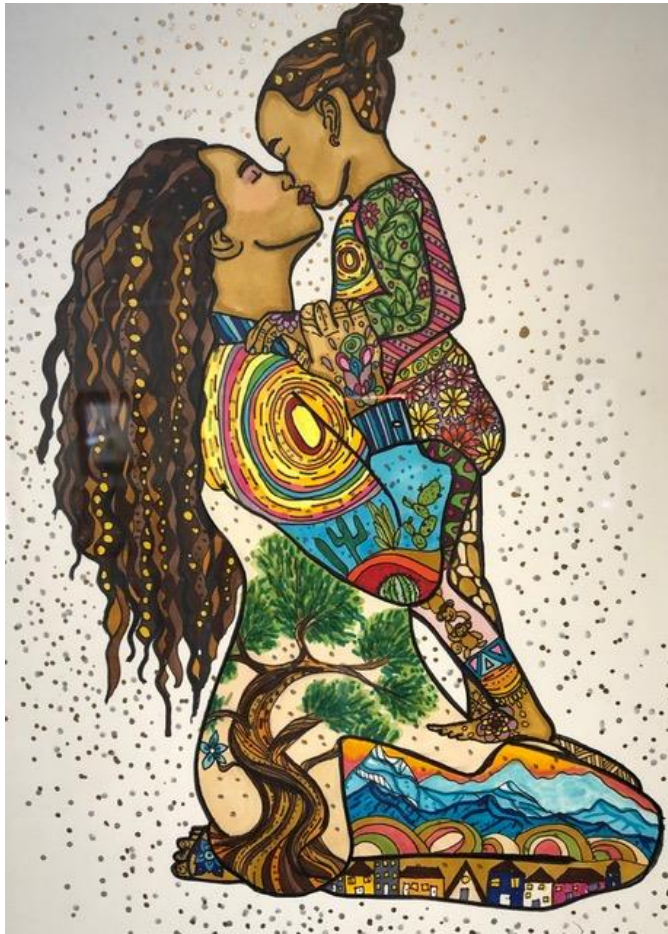
This Kissler painting represents what nature provides in Washington's high country.

this pen marker, Healing Kisses by Sarah Grubich

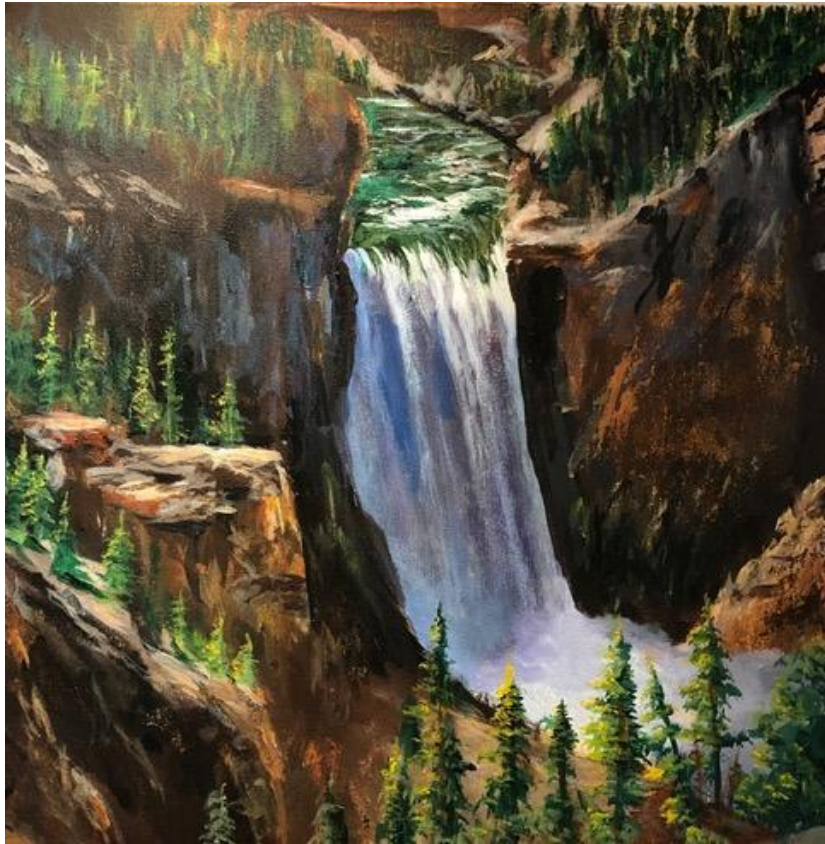


And this pen & pencil, Sketchbook Family by Dan McConnell.
