Charitable Foundation
The "Spirit of Pybus" Poster Contest Rules
2020

- The contest is open to all residents of Chelan, Douglas, Grant and Okanogan counties.
- Artwork must portray the "Spirit of Pybus:" a theme or image associated with Pybus Market – either its people, products or physical structure (interior or exterior). Artwork must be an original, unpublished work.
- Artwork may be in a painted or drawn medium. Entries may be drawn, painted or sketched using pens, pencils, crayons or charcoal, oil, acrylic or watercolor paint. No photography or computer enhanced or computer animated work, please.
- Artwork should be suitable for a finished vertical poster approx. 16" x 20." The name "Pybus Market" may be incorporated into the design
- Submit artwork in a high resolution format to Pybus Market, via disk or email, by April 1,2020 with name, address, phone number, email address and short bio/resume.
- Entries are due April 1,2020 and the winner will be announced on May 3,2020.
- Winning artist will receive \$500.00 along with 20 free prints. Second place will receive \$100.00. Pybus Market will host an unveiling reception at a mutually agreeable time.
- Artist shall retain ownership of the original artwork and may sell the original at his/her discretion. Pybus Market may, in its discretion, sell or give the artwork to a winery for use as a wine label.
