### Wenatchee Downtown Association Seeks Mural Artists

WENATCHEE — Mural artists are being sought by the Wenatchee Downtown Association's Design Committee. This project is downtown on Wenatchee Avenue between Café Mela and The Antique Mall of Wenatchee.

Artists are invited to submit proposals that include pricing and overall conceptual ideas.

Basic guidelines include::

• The design should be timeless and locally oriented.

• Reference the past while being understandable in the future.

• Currently appropriate and represents diverse community.

Proposals should be submitted by May 15. The project should be completed by October. The wall is 50 feet wide by 16 feet high.

### **Report from your Gallery Board**

#### Grant Facilitator Report:

The Gallery has received a \$1,000 grant from the Walker Fund Familv through the Community Foundation. Terri Timpe has written a thank you letter and passed it around for the board members to sign. The Community Foundation Regional Impact Grant was submitted on March 2<sup>nd</sup>. Because of the structure of our Gallery, we did not meet the new requirements for the Regional Impact Grant of \$10K but we do qualify for a \$4K grant which she has applied for. The Icicle Fund Grant application did not get funded. A lot of work and effort goes into our applications and it is a disappointment to not be accepted.

#### **Board Members Renewal:**

It was moved, seconded and voted to renew the expiring memberships of Russ Hepler, Carole Hiatt and Adelle Johnson for additional three year terms. It was also voted to welcome Terri Meenach back as a working board member for a three year term.



#### Plein Air Paint Out:

Ideas were discussed for both this year and next year's contests. A suggestion for 2023 was the Riverwalk's 30<sup>th</sup> anniversary. The subject of wineries, most likely held in the fall, was suggested for this year. We are considering a paint out at a winery tasting room or winery of your choice. More information to come. Dan Crandall is approaching Chelan wineries for donations and participation in a plein air activity. Dan has approached Bianchi Winery about the activity and obtained the wine donation for the April First Friday.

#### Art Intake Change:

Art Intake will change to Sunday and Monday from 10:00AM to 2:00 PM beginning with the May/June exhibit to avoid congestion on days the Gallery is regularly open. More info to come in our next prospectus.

#### Mask Requirement:

The Board decided to announce a decision soon about mask requirement at the gallery. It was required for April First Friday as many guests crowd into our small rooms. From now on the door could remain open during our events thus making a safer environment.


