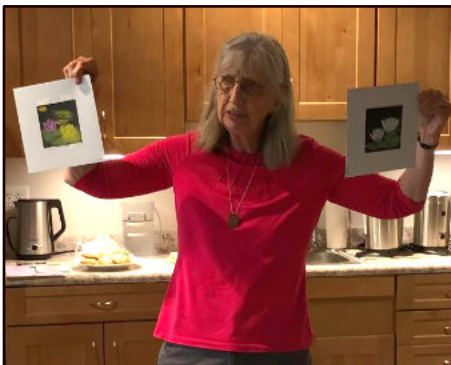

Learn to Create With Pastels

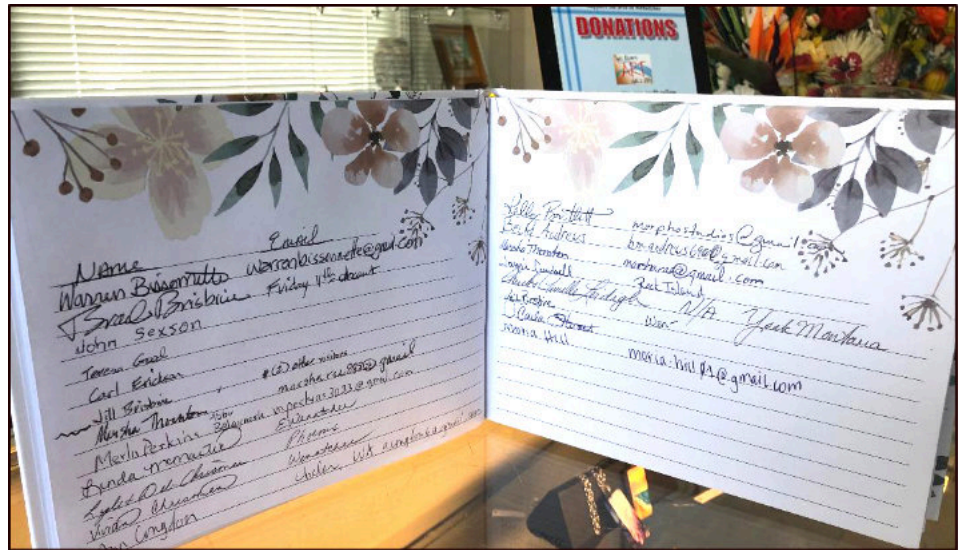

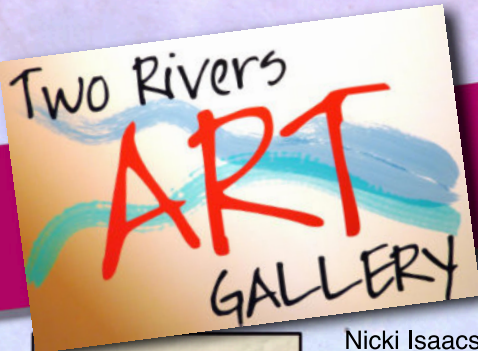
Notes of Interest:

Nicki Isaacson began pursuing art 20 years ago. Now retired she is enjoying uninterrupted time with her brushes.

"I'm a detail person, I love capturing things you don't see as you rush through your day: the center of a flower, the curve of a petal, the lines in a leaf; or how light glances off an apple or cherry."

"Watercolor is the perfect medium. It's transparent. It allows you to layer paint without losing the light that shines through the pigments, giving the painting depth of color."

Nicki is a member of the Wenatchee Watercolor Society and has served on the board of Two Rivers Art Gallery where she has been a featured artist 3 times. She has been the artist for the Apple Blossom Festival, and a Pybus Market poster. And shown in the Pybus Market Art Alley.
